



WINDOW ART

Set Up Your Work Area.

Lay out all of your materials in front of you and plan out your designs. Protect your work area by completely covering it with large trash bags or another type of plastic sheeting. Keep the packaging in front of you in case you want to refer to the pictures as a guide.

NOTE TO PARENTS: Please read these instructions carefully and completely. Adult supervision is recommended on these projects.

Adding Lava To Your Mesh Pieces!

First decide what colors you would like to use on your pieces. Start off with a base color and then add details in different colors. Once you have mapped out your design begin to spread the lava onto the mesh pieces to create a thin layer over the mesh. Once you have spread the lava, pat it down onto the mesh lightly to make sure it stays attached. Allow the lava to dry overnight.

Note: Once the lava is dry, you can always add more lava on top to give your pieces extra sparkle.

Adding Lava To Your Sun Catchers!

Decide which sun catcher you are going to decorate first and plan out the colors that you are going to use. Lay the sun catcher flat on your work area with the side with the raised lines facing up. Spread the lava over the desired areas. Once you have finished, let the lava dry overnight.

Note: You can also use your package or tray to hold your mesh pieces and suncatchers while they dry.

Show Off Your Designs!

Now that you have decorated your mesh pieces and sun catchers, it's time to turn your windows into works of art. First, cut a piece of string to your desired length. Then place the string through holes on the top of your mesh pieces and suncatchers and tie a knot to secure. Find a place on your window or in your room to show off your creations!

Cleaning Instructions:

If you get lava in undesired areas, here are some helpful hints to clean it off.

- Before lava has dried: Gently rub the lava off until only a light residue remains. Then soak the item in warm water with soap.
- After lava has dried: Soak the item in warm water with soap. Once the lava has softened gently rub the lava off.
